Door Speakers: <u>6x9 Standard Depth 3</u>" WHEN INSTALLING AN AFTERMARKET 5 ½" OR 6 ½" SPEAKER, SA69 ADAPTER IS REQUIRED.

REAR SPEAKERS:

Rear Side Panel Speakers: <u>6x9" Standard Depth 4"</u> WHEN INSTALLING AN AFTERMARKET 5 1/4" OR 6 1/2 " SPEAKERS, SA69 ADAPTER IS NEEDED.

2001 Chrysler Town and country Minivan

PRELIMINARY: Disconnect the negative battery cable.

ANTENNA: The factory antenna is located atop the passenger's side front fender.

RADIO REMOVAL AND IN-DASH INSTALLATION:

- Note: The factory radio provision is for a custom contoured Chrysler DIN+1/2 style. An installation kit is necessary when using an Aftermarket radio. We recommend the use of a Scosche CR1277 kit.
- 1. Open drink holder and remove screw cover panel at bottom of radio bezel, extract (2) phillips screws from behind.
- 2. Using a panel removal tool, unsnap, disconnect, and remove the dash bezel.
- 3. Extract (4) Philips head screws securing radio, lift away, disconnect and remove.

DASH SPEAKER REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION:

- Note: The factory provision is for a 5 ¼" 2-hole pin cushion speaker mounted to the dash. No adapter is needed when installing an aftermarket 5 ¼" speaker.
- 1.Remove "A" pillar panels using panel removal tool, on passengers side you must remove passenger assist handle by extracting (2) 10mm bolts first.
- 2.Pry upwards on front of dash panel, then pull out to remove once all fasteners are loose.
- 3.Extract (2) Philips screws securing speaker, disconnect and remove.

FRONT DOOR SPEAKER REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION:

- Note: The factory speaker provision is for a 6x9" 4-hole pin cushion speaker mounted to the door. When installing an aftermarket 5 ¼" or 6 ½" speaker, we recommend the use of a Scosche SA69 speaker adapter.
- 1. Extract (1) Philips head screws from bottom front portion of door panel.
- 2. Remove screw cover from door handle and extract (1) phillips screw from behind.
- 3. Remove screw cover from door cup and extract (1) Philips screw from behind.
- 4. Using a panel removal tool, pry off the door panel, disconnect and remove.
- 5. Extract (4) Philips head screws securing speaker, lift away, disconnect and remove.

REAR SPEAKER REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION:

Note: The factory speaker provision is for a 6x9" mounted in the rear side panels.

- 1. Pry off speaker grile, lift away and remove.
- 2. Extract (4) Philips head screws securing speaker, lift away, disconnect and remove.
