Disconnect the negative battery cable.

RADIO



- 1. Pull handle on center console to release then remove.
- 2. Use PRT to unclip panel to the left of the radio and remove.
- 3. Use PRT to unclip side window defroster panel and remove.
- 4. Use PRT to unclip side dash panel and remove.
- 5. Use PRT to unclip panel to the right of the radio and remove.
- 6. Use PRT to unclip a/c panel, unplug and remove.
- 7. Use PRT to unclip right side panel of lower console and remove.
- 8. Use PRT to remove clip on left side panel of lower console.
- 9. Use PRT to unclip left side panel of lower console and remove.
- 10. Unscrew (2) phillip head screws, (1) located on both sides of lower console behind panels that were just removed.
- 11. Unscrew (4) phillip head screws securing lower console.
- 12. Use PRT to unclip lower console, unplug and remove.
- 13. Unscrew (4) 8mm bolts securing radio.
- 14. Unplug radio and remove.

FRONT DOOR SPEAKERS

- 4. Unscrew (2) phillip head screws located behind the panel that was just removed.
- 5. Use PRT to loosen door handle.
- 6. Use PRT to unclip window switch, unplug and remove.
- 7. Unscrew (1) phillips head screw located behind the panel that was just removed.
- 8. Use PRT to unclip door, unplug harness and remove.
- 9. Unscrew (1) phillips head screw securing speaker, unplug and remove.
