#### PRELIMINARY:

Disconnect the negative battery cable.

## **VEHICLE DISASSEMBLY**

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### RADIO REMOVAL

- 1) Drape a protective cloth over the front fender.
- 2) Extract (3) T-27 Torx bolts from bottom edge of windshield.
- 3) Carefully lift away windshield, store in a safe location and replace the middle Torx bolt for support during the remaining removal steps.
- 4) Extract (2) T-27 Torx bolts from outer side of the fairing (under mirrors)
- 5) Extract (2) T-27 Torx bolts from inside the fork tubes (facing forward)
- 6) While supporting the outer fairing, remove the middle windshield bolt, lift away and unplug headlight to remove fairing shell. Store fairing in a safe place until re-assembling.
- 7) Unbolt and remove innerfairing support brackets from each side (3/16 HEX" & T-25 Torx screws) Note the Torx screw is also a shared speaker screw.
- 8) Extract (2) ¼" 6 MM Hex bolts from each side of the radio housing.
- 9) Carefully back the radio out of the fairing, unplug wiring connectors, antenna and remove the radio.



### FRONT SPEAKERS



- Follow the same outer fairing removal steps to access or replace the radio to access the Factory speakers.
- 2) Use a T-25 Torx driver and extract (4) screws securing each speaker, unplug and remove speakers & spacers.
