

INTRODUCTION/PRELIMINARY

This premium installation kit is for 2016-Up Subaru BRZ vehicles. Included are all the parts you need to mount your car stereo or CD player into your vehicle's dash. Refer to individual instruction in this manual to remove your vehicle's factory radio and assemble the kit.

CAUTION: DISCONNECT YOUR VEHICLE NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL BEFORE THE INSTALLATION TO HELP PREVENT ELECTRICAL DAMAGE. WE RECOMMEND THE USE OF A VOLT/ OHM METER OVER A TEST LIGHT TO CHECK WIRING. A TEST LIGHT OR GROUNDED WIRE PROBE CAN CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE'S COMPUTER AND/OR DIAGNOSTIC SYSTEMS. AVOID ALL FACTORY AIRBAG WIRING - AIRBAGS CAN ACCIDENTALLY DEPLOY CAUSING SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

Step 1

Disassembly


2017 Subaru BRZ OEM Dash Overview



Step 2

Disassembly

Using a panel removal tool carefully remove the passenger panel located on the front dash. (located just right of the radio, see image)



Step 3

Disassembly

Use a panel removal tool to pry around the perimeter of the radio face panel to help unsnap from the dashboard.



Step 4

Disassembly

Using a 10mm socket remove the four bolts used to secure the radio to the dash. Two located on the LEFT and two located on RIGHT, retain bolts for reinstall.

Unplug and remove the radio from location then proceed to either single din installation on page 3 or double din installation steps on page 4.



Step 5

Single Din Assembly

Mount the provided pocket to the back of the SU2032B face panel.




Step 6

Single Din Assembly

Mount the provided pocket to the back of the SU2032B face pane.






Step 7

Single Din Assembly

Slide and adjust the aftermarket radio into the bracket assembly, then secure once proper fitment is determined.




Step 8

Single Din Assembly

Reassemble **Connect**

everything with the new aftermarket panel in reverse order.






Step 9

Double Din Assembly


Mount and screw into place the provided brackets (LEFT & Right) to back of the Scosche SU2032B face panel (See illustration).






Step 10 Double Din Assembly

Slide and secure the double DIN aftermarket radio unit into place then proceed to the next step (See illustration).
