

# INTRODUCTION/PRELIMINARY

This premium installation kit is for Select 2005-UP CHRYSLER, DODGE, & JEEP vehicles with navigation. Included are all the parts you need to mount your car stereo/cassette or CD player into your vehicle's dash. Refer to the individual instruction in this manual to remove your vehicle's factory radio and assemble the kit.

### CAUTION:

Disconnect your vehicle's negative battery terminal before the installation to help prevent electrical damage. We recommend the use of a volt/ohm meter over a test light to check wiring. A test light or grounded wire probe can cause damage to the vehicle's computer and/or diagnostic systems. Avoid all factory airbag wiring - airbags can accidentally deploy causing serious injury or death.

### NOTES:

- See your vehicle's instructions for any special tools your installation might require.
- Read all instructions accompanying your car stereo/cassette player for proper wiring and mounting instructions.






### **ISO DIN MOUNT**

# **RADIO REMOVAL**

# 2007 CHRYSLER ASPEN; 2004-UP DODGE DURANGO RADIO REMOVAL:

- 1. Extract (2) 7mm screws from underneath the front dash bezel surrounding the radio and AC controls. The bolts are located in the cubby hole in front of the center console.
- 2. Using panel removal tool pop out radio dash bezel and remove.
- 3. Extract (4) 7mm screws securing radio. Disconnect and remove

### 2005-UP DODGE CHARGER; 2005-UP DODGE MAGNUM RADIO REMOVAL:

- 1. Using a panel removal tool, unsnap and remove the trim around the radio and climate control bracket that holds the A/C vents.
- 2. Remove the 10mm bolts holding the radio and climate control bracket. Disconnect and remove.

# 2006-UP DODGE RAM / RAM MEGA

### **RADIO REMOVAL:**

- 1. Fold down cup holder panel in center dash. Extract (2) 9/32<sup>11</sup> PhillIps head screws from underneath dash panel above cup holder.
- 2. Using a panel removal tool, Remove entire radio bezel and AC controls. Disconnect and remove.
- 3. Extract (4) 9/32" Phillps head screws securing the radio to dash. Disconnect and remove.

## 2005-UP CHRYSLER 300C

### **RADIO REMOVAL:**

- 1. Using a panel removal tool remove the trim around the radio and climate control bracket that holds the A/C vents.
- 2. Extract (4) 7mm screws securing radio. Disconnect and remove.

### 2005-UP JEEP GRAND CHEROKEE

### **RADIO REMOVAL:**

- 1. Using panel removal tool carefully unsnap radio trim bezel. Lift away & remove.
- 2. Extract (4) 7mm screws securing the radio. Lift away, disconnect & remove

### 2006-UP JEEP COMMANDER

### **RADIO REMOVAL:**

- 1. Remove (16) silver Allen head screws from front of dash.
- Carefully pull dash from right front corner to release retainer clips. Then continue releasing retainer clips along top of dash from righ to left. There are two clips on dash above steering column that need to be released. There is 1 clip on dash right below radio. Once all clips released remove dash.
- 3. Extract (4) 7mm screws securing the radio, disconnect and remove.
