# **MOUNTING THE RADIO**

### **DOUBLE DIN-ISO & 2 DIN-ISO MOUNT**

# (DIN-E Radio with Side Mounting Holes)

- Snap the DIN-ISO side mounting brackets to the back of the mounting panel (1 left and 1 right). Use supplied hardware to bolt them to the back of the kit panel.
- 2. Snap the DIN-ISO trim ring into the radio opening.
- Load the radio from the REAR of the mounting panel until the nose piece of the radio comes through the front of the kit.
- 4. Use the 5MM screws to secure the radio from the sides. VARIOUS REAR SUPPORTS (NOT INCLUDED) **CAUTION:** REAR SUPPORTING THE RADIO ADDS TO THE BRACKET INSTALLATION'S STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY. VARIOUS REAR SUPPORTS (NOT INCLUDED) BRACKET 5906 KIT **5907 TRIM** 59081 5906 KIT 5907 TRIM PANEL

### **RADIO REMOVAL**

- 1. Using a panel removal tool, remove the trim around the radio and climate control.
- Extract (8) Phillips head screws securing A/C controls and radio. Lift away, disconnect, and remove.

NOTE: Factory Radio has anti-theft lockout when unplugged. It can only be reset by a Chevrolet dealership.


### **RADIO REMOVAL**

- 1. Open center console compartment, extract (4) Phillips screws securing compartment lid and remove.
- 2. Pop up leather parking brake boot and extract (2) hex screws from behind.
- Use a panel removal tool to pop out the passenger airbag indicator panel (rear edge first), unplug and remove.
- 4. Extract (2) hex screws revealed in step 3.
- 5. Carefully pop out entire radio/climate control bezel, unplug all connections and remove.
- 6. Extract (6) hex screws holding radio/climate assembly, unplug and remove.
